


The AEB has posted its Draft Copy of the 2009 Multi-Jurisdictional Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan (MHMP). (See below to download PDF document.) The MHMP includes information to assist the Borough and city/tribal governments and residents with planning to avoid potential future disaster losses. The plan provides risk assessment information on natural hazards that affect the AEB and descriptions of past disasters, such as earthquakes, tsunamis, volcanoes and severe weather. 
