## **ADF&G Staff To Present WASSIP Update, SEDM Genetic Sampling at AEB Fishermen's Meeting in Seattle**

ADF&G will be available at the AEB Fishermen's meeting (scheduled for Nov. 18, 2010 at 10 a.m. at the Silver Cloud Inn) to cover the following topics:

- 1) WASSIP update: Eric Volk will be able to provide information on how the samples taken for the past several years are being processed. In addition, he may have some preliminary information on stock identification for chum and sockeye stocks.
  - 2) Kodiak staff will be prepared to discuss how to conduct next summer's SEDM genetic sampling program. There were some problems with this year's effort, and the Department wants to work with fishermen to make sure that we have better success next summer.
  - 3) ADF&G will also go over this summer's fishery.
