


Nelson Lagoon & False Pass Public Meetings on Izembek DEIS Land Exchange/Road Corridor Scheduled for 7 p.m. Tonight via Teleconference

Because of poor weather, officials with the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service (USFWS) will be unable to travel to Nelson Lagoon and False Pass today for the public meetings on the draft environmental impact statement for the Izembek/King Cove land exchange/road corridor.

Therefore, the public meetings will be conducted via teleconference. **Nelson Lagoon's meeting will be moved from 2 p.m. today to 7 p.m. tonight to coincide with False Pass** so testimony

from both communities can be taken during the same teleconference call. Residents in False Pass and Nelson Lagoon can participate by dialing in, using the following toll-free number:
