

## The Deadline for Comments on the Izembek – King Cove Land Exchange & Road Corridor is Tomorrow

If you haven't submitted comments on the Izembek – King Cove land exchange and road corridor draft environmental impact statement (DEIS), you still have time to express your opinion. **The deadline is tomorrow (Friday, May 18, 2012).**

Public meetings held in the AEB communities last week drew a large number of people wanting to make sure their voices were heard on this important issue. Another meeting was held in

All public comments received, including respondent names and addresses, will be included in the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) administrative record, which, upon request, will be available for public review. If you provide comments in your official capacity as a representative of an organization or business, the USFWS can, by law, only accept your comment if you include your full name and complete contact information. If you are commenting as an individual and you want us to withhold your name or contact information, please state this prominently at the beginning of your comments. The USFWS will honor your request to the extent allowed by law.
