



RESOLUTION 19-56

A RESOLUTION OF THE ALEUTIANS EAST BOROUGH ASSEMBLY SUPPORTING THE APPOINTMENT OF CORA CAMPBELL TO THE NORTH PACIFIC FISHERY MANAGEMENT COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, Ms. Cora Campbell of Anchorage Alaska, who grew up in a commercial fishing family in Petersburg, Alaska has been selected as one of Governor Dunleavy's preferred nominees for a three year term on the North Pacific Fishery Management Council; and

WHEREAS, the Secretary of Commerce will make the final determination for appointments to the Council in June; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Campbell has decades of experience as a commercial fisherman; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Campbell has extensive fisheries policy and regulation experience and has served as Commissioner for the Alaska Department of Fish and Game under two governors of the State; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Campbell is currently the president and CEO of Silver Bay Seafoods; and

WHEREAS, Silver Bay Seafoods LLC will be opening a new processing plant in False Pass this coming June; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Campbell has served on numerous fishery boards and committees, including United Fisherman of Alaska, the North Pacific Fisheries Management Council and the Alaska Seafood Marketing Institute.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Aleutians East Borough Assembly supports the appointment of Cora Campbell to the North Pacific Fishery Management Council.
