



ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 07-08

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 2, CHAPTERS 2.04.010, 2.04.020 and 2.04.030

WHEREAS, the legislative power of the Aleutians East Borough is vested with the Assembly pursuant to Alaska State Statute 29.20.050; and

WHEREAS, on February 20, 2007, a majority of residents of the Borough voted in support of a seven (7) assembly seat election district where each seat is voted for “at large by the voters throughout the borough”; and

WHEREAS, Title 2, Chapter 2.04 of the Aleutians East Borough Municipal Code presently allows for assembly members to be elected by district rather than by “at large”; and

WHEREAS, this amendment is necessary in order that the Borough’s Municipal Code comply with the February 20, 2007 election results.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE ALEUTIANS EAST BOROUGH:

Section 1. **Classification.** This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become part of the borough code.

Section 2. **Severability.** If any provision of this ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. **Effectiveness.** This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.

Section 4: **Adoption by Section.** Code sections 2.04.010, 2.04.020 and 2.04.030 are hereby repealed and Code Sections 2.04.010, 2.04.020 and 2.04.030 as annexed hereto as part of this ordinance are hereby adopted as Code Section 2.04.010, 2.04.020 and 2.04.030 of the Code of Ordinances of the Aleutians East Borough.

2.04.010 Borough Assembly – Composition and Appointment.

The Assembly shall consist of seven members, elected to seats, identified as Seat A-G, elected at large by the qualified voters of the borough.

2.04.020 Qualifications of Assembly and School Board Members.

The assembly and school board members shall be qualified electors of the borough, and shall have been a resident within the borough for a minimum of one (1) year prior to holding office. An assembly or school board member who ceases to be eligible to be a borough voter immediately forfeits his office.

2.04.030 Election of Assembly and School Board Members -- Terms.

(a) An election is held annually on the first Tuesday of October, to chose assembly and school board members for three year terms and until their successors are elected and have qualified. In the event that a new form of representation is adopted, upon certification of the results, the assembly and school board members elected at such election shall determine by lot the length of the terms of office so that the terms of two (2) members shall be for one (1) year, the terms of two (2) members shall be for two (2) years, and the term of three (3) members shall be for three (3) years, resulting in staggered terms of office for all members subsequently elected.

(b) The regular term of office begins on the first Monday following the election.

(c) The assembly may provide by ordinance for different terms not to exceed three (3) years, except that the current term of incumbent assembly members may not be altered.
