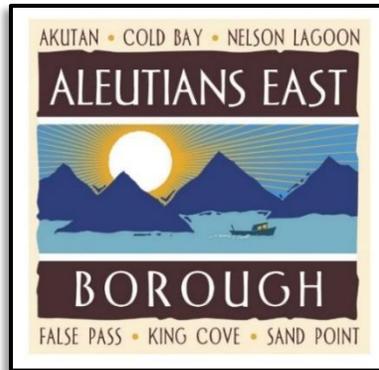


KSDP Interviews ADF&G Commissioner & Deputy Commissioner about Fisheries Relief Funding through the CARES Act

If you missed KSDP's live interview yesterday with ADF&G Commissioner Doug Vincent-Lang and Deputy Commissioner Rachel Baker, you can still listen to the archived recording. KSDP General Manager Austin Roof interviewed Vincent-Lang and Baker about how \$50 million in fisheries relief funding, due to COVID-19-related impacts, will be distributed to five different groups within the Alaska fishing industry.
