

Sand Point Police Department COVID-19 FAQ

What is Mandate 10 and who does it apply to?

- Mandate 10 requires all people coming into Alaska to fill out forms in the airport and requires a mandatory 14-day self-quarantine. It does not apply to intrastate travel.

What is Mandate 11?

- Mandate 11 covers the requirements for social distancing, limits gathering sizes and closes businesses and government activities that are not essential. Mandate 12 is the order that closed all bars, gyms and dine-in restaurants.

What is Mandate 12?

- Mandate 12 bans all intrastate travel except for travel to support critical infrastructure or for critical personal needs.

How long are Mandate 11 and Mandate 12 in effect?

- They are in effect until April 11 and April 21, respectively. Each mandate will be reevaluated at that time.

Is commercial fishing banned under Mandate 12?

-No. Commercial fishing is explicitly exempted under Mandate 12, but it does request that vessels monitor crew for illness and to mitigate the risk of exposure to communities they visit.

If I am a crew member, do I have to remain on the boat?

-No. Crew members, however, are still subject to Mandate 11 and the guidelines it set forth.

Is Sand Point's 14-day quarantine for people arriving to town required?

- The 14-day quarantine is strictly voluntary at this time, but the City requests people self-quarantine for the 14-day period to prevent the spread of COVID-19, which has not yet reached Sand Point.

Some cities have travel bans and mandatory quarantines, is Sand Point going to do something similar?

- At this point, the City is following the State's lead on travel restrictions and quarantines and does not have plans to take further measures.
