

RESOLUTION 07-08

A RESOLUTION OF THE ALEUTIANS EAST BOROUGH CALLING FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF RESOLVING A RUNOFF FOR A SCHOOL BOARD SEAT AND TO APPOINT A CANVASS COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, Title 4, Sec. 4.04.070 requires in excess of 40% of the votes cast for the seats for which the candidates are running, and

WHEREAS, District 2, King Cove School Board Seat B candidates Marty Newton and Jacki Bendixen neither received in excess of 40% of the votes cast in the October 3, 2006 regular election.

WHEREAS, Title 4, Section 4.40.020 allows the clerk to conduct entire special elections by mail.

WHEREAS, Title 4, Section 4.40.050 allows the clerk to appoint city clerks or others in the area to act as absentee voting officials.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Assembly:

1. On November 14, 2006, a special election to be held to resolve the issue between the Borough school board candidates above.
2. The special election will be conducted by mail with an assistant clerk in the community of King Cove.
3. The following serve as canvass committee to canvass all votes:



1. The above list of persons is appointed to serve in the November 14, 2006 special election.


2. They shall serve under the direction of the borough clerk to conduct the election and canvass in a proper manner.
