

RESOLUTION 21-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE ALEUTIANS EAST BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AUTHORIZING ADMINISTRATION TO DETERMINE AND IMPLEMENT THE BEST APPROACH TO SPEND THE REMAINING ALEUTIANS EAST BOROUGH CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND EXONOMIC SECURITY (CARES) ACT FUNDS BY DECEMBER 30, 2020

WHEREAS, at the August 7, 2020 Assembly Meeting, the Assembly approved Resolution 21-10 approving the Aleutians East Borough's Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act Funds; and

WHEREAS, \$3,723,853.74 has been appropriated to the following: Emergency Assistance and Economic Stimulus Grant; Non-Profit and Civic Organization Relief Program; and Cold Bay Community Center Conversion; Personal Protection Equipment/Cleaning Supplies; Payroll Expenditures, Legal Fees, Alaska Municipal League Support; KSDP Support, Election Needs; Anchorage office air purification system; indoor air quality upgrades; costs related to the postponement of projects and Eastern Aleutian Tribes; and

WHEREAS, through October 30, 2020 the Borough has expended \$648,634.76 in CARES Act Funds; and

WHEREAS, Administration does not anticipate spending the full amounts allocated to all of the CARES Act appropriations; and

WHEREAS, Administration is considering a few options to use the funds; and

WHEREAS, Administration is requesting authorization from the Assembly to determine and implement the best course of action to spend the remaining CARES Act funds by the December 30, 2020 deadline.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Aleutians East Borough Assembly authorizes Administration to determine and implement the best approach to spend the remaining Aleutians East Borough Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act Funds by December 30, 2020.
