A RESOLUTION BY THE ALEUTIANS EAST BOROUGH ASSEMBLY HONORING THE LIFE, LEGACY, AND DEDICATED PUBLIC SERVICE OF FORMER BOROUGH MAYOR STANLEY MACK

WHEREAS, Stanley Mack was born in King Cove and lived in Cold Bay and Sand Point; and

WHEREAS, Stanley was a lifelong fisherman and was deeply rooted in the Aleutians culture, communities and fishing heritage; and

WHEREAS, in 1972, Stanley was first elected as a City of Sand Point Council Member, where he served as a Council Member and then Mayor for numerous years; and

WHEREAS, Stanley served as the Mayor of the City of Sand Point for two terms and in November 2002, was elected mayor of the Aleutians East Borough, becoming the second mayor in the Borough's history; and

WHEREAS, Stanley served as Borough mayor until 2017, providing 15 years of leadership and unwavering dedication to the residents of the Borough's communities; and

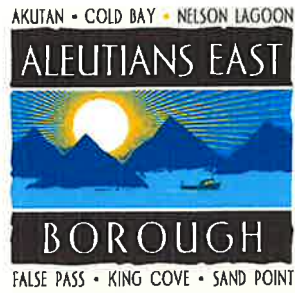
WHEREAS, during his tenure, Stanley played an instrumental role in shaping the Borough's future by completing capital projects and advocating for the King Cove Road, the fisheries and other items; and

WHEREAS, even after leaving public office, Stanley remained committed to serving the region and most recently provided testimony before the Alaska Board of Fisheries during its February 20226 meeting; and

WHEREAS, Stanley Mack passed away on July 14, 2026.

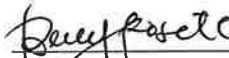
